

Hello Moms, Grandparents, and other loved ones,

Here, you will find the prank guidelines and video requirements.

Please follow these to make editing as effective as possible.

If these guidelines are not followed, your video will need to be redone or it will not be used, unfortunately.

Here are the prank guidelines for your children:

- Get creative and make it fun!
 - No bodily harm in any way
 - No property damage
- Act of out love! How would Jesus respond to this prank?
 - Prank ideas (you can other ones though!):
- Hide alarm clocks around the house to go off at different times
 - Cover Dad with TP/shaving cream while he's sleeping
 - Prank call him from an unknown number
 - Put salt in his hot coffee or tea
 - Hide all of his shoes
 - Cover his car with post it notes
 - Hide in a secret place to pop out and scare him
- Put a fake animal by him while he's sleeping and scream!
- Change the language settings on his phone to another language

Video Requirements

1. Turn off all notifications and ringers. If possible, place phone on do not disturb or airplane mode. Make sure phone is charged!
2. Take video in the daytime, with natural light if possible. Do not record on a rainy, stormy or very windy day.
3. Record with LOTS of light (natural or artificial) so we can see you all well. And clean your camera screen!
4. Limit background noise (airplanes, vacuums, TV, etc.).
5. Record videos with **your device in horizontal/landscape mode**.
6. Try to keep your phone level (not shaky). You could prop it up.
7. Leave at least **2 seconds** before beginning the prank and **2 seconds** before ending the video.

You can send up to 3 different prank videos so get creative!
